



# Cultural and Public Arts Commission

The Cultural and Public Art Commission meets on the third Thursday of every other month. The staff liaison will call other meetings as needed. The commission provides aesthetic considerations and promotes public art as a mechanism to foster civic pride, community health, diversity, equity, and inclusion with the guidance of the Public Art Master Plan. The Commission has seven voting members and up to four non-voting members, serving a two-year term.
